

Operation Encompass at Leasowe Primary School

In conjunction with Merseyside Police, Leasowe Primary School is involved in an initiative called Operation Encompass.

The purpose of Operation Encompass is to safeguard and support children and young people who have been involved in, heard or witnessed a domestic abuse incident.

Following such an incident, children can arrive at school distressed, upset, worried and unprepared. Operation Encompass aims to ensure that appropriate school staff (called Key Adults) are made aware early enough to support children and young people in a way that means they feel safe and included.

At Leasowe Primary School our Mrs Hill (Designated Safeguarding Lead), Mrs Piggott (Deputy Safeguarding Lead) and Miss Green (Deputy Safeguarding Lead)

This is a valuable initiative that means we can continue to support and help children and families within our school community when they need it the most.
