LPS employ Andy Wilde to deliver quality first gymnastic coaching sessions. Our Key Stage two Pupils have weekly access to Propulsion coaching and facilities (off site activity) Pupils receive coaching from Andy Wilde and Ellie Jordan. Children who demonstrate a skillset in trampolining will be given the opportunity to begin training in the Propulsion training school. Our pupil work through a programme of study devised by British Gymnastics and are assessed using the British Gymnastic proficiency scale Our Leasowe Gymnastic team are competing Nationally in trampolining & DMT.
